Children's and Teen Areas

Children's and Teen areas in Cass County Public Library branches are specifically designed and reserved for the use of children under the age of 18 and their caregivers, or patrons using the children's collections, seeking assistance from library staff, or attending children's area programs at the discretion of library staff.

Children's areas provide resources specifically for children, including computers with Internet access for children through 5th grade, and regular and special programs targeting the needs of specific age groups.

Children's and teen areas are open during regular branch open hours.

Except when using the children's collection, seeking assistance from library staff, or attending children's programs, adult patrons unaccompanied by a child are restricted from use of children's areas.

Teen areas are bound by the same guidelines, and use may be restricted during certain hours or times of the year to best accommodate teenagers and their library needs.
