New at Find a Grave

Memorial Transfer Opportunity

Find a Grave has announced that it is now allowing users to submit a manager request for any memorial currently managed by Find a Grave. These are typically memorials previously managed by users who are now deceased or inactive.

Using the *Memorials* search, type the number **8** into the *Contributor ID* field of the search form, then click search. You will get a list of all "available" memorials up for grabs. On a memorial's page, click *Suggest Edits* and you will be prompted at the top of the page to submit a *Request to Manage*.
